TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

January 17th (9:00am) – **NOVICE** continues until completion

January 17th (8:15-8:45am) – *ELITE* RED DOT Weight Check (1kg allowance) *ELITE* tournament to follow novice after a short warm-up break

High School ELITE Division

Eligibility:

Elite is mainly for athletes with more than a year of experience and good rookies. If an athlete meets any of the following criteria they **MUST** compete in the elite competition and cannot compete in the novice competition.

- 1. They are currently a grade 11 or 12 student with 1 or more years of wrestling experience.
- 2. They placed in the top 4 at last year's high school provincial championships.

NOTE: We understand there are extenuating circumstances at times, so coaches, we trust you to use your best judgment on the division to enter your athletes in.

If there is a question on what division, please err on the side of bumping them up to elite.

Weigh-Ins:

- Weigh-in information must be input into "TrackWrestling" online program by 8:00PM on Thursday, January 15th. There will be an email sent to all coaches with link, username/password and instructions for "TrackWrestling."
- The draw will be made available late Thursday night or early Friday morning. Please review and let us know about any issues.

Weight Classes:

Male: 41, 44, 47, 50, 53, 56, 59, 62, 65, 69, 73, 77, 82, 90, 100, 115, 130 & 130+

Female: 44, 47, 50, 53, 56, 60, 64, 68, 73, 80, 90, 105, 105+

Red Dot Weight Checks (ELITE ONLY):

- One athlete from each team will be randomly selected to participate in the Red Dot weight checks (posted in the morning). Athletes who are involved in the weight check will be required to check weight with a 1kg allowance.
- If the athlete misses weight, their team will be required to weigh-in.
- Any athlete that proceeds to miss weight (w/ the 1kg allowance) will be required to move up to the appropriate weight class. Athletes will not be removed from the competition

Awards:

"TOURNAMENT CHAMPION" T-Shirts will be presented to the winners of each weight class Medals will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place athletes in each weight class Tournament MVP awards for Male & Female division

High School NOVICE Division

Eligibility:

The novice division is for mainly 1st year wrestlers and very inexperienced 2nd year wrestlers.

NOTE: We understand there are extenuating circumstances at times, so coaches, we trust you to use your best judgment on the division to enter your athletes in.

If there is a question on what division, please err on the side of bumping them up to elite.

Weigh-Ins:

- Weigh-in information must be input into "TrackWrestling" online program by 8:00PM on Thursday, January 15th. There will be an email sent to all coaches with link,
- The draw will be made available late Thursday night or early Friday morning. Please review and let us know about any issues.

Weight Classes:

Athletes will be placed in pools of 5 or 6 according to scratch weight.

Awards:

Medals will be presented to the Winner of each pool
