COACHES' BRIEFING

This information serves as the official **COACHES' BRIEFING** for the Annual (U9 to U19), South Saskatchewan Wrestling Championships, scheduled for this Sunday, February 8th.

Event Guidelines

- 1. **Coaches' Registration:** It is mandatory for all attending coaches to register as a "Coach" on TrackWrestling. Additionally, coaches must be fully registered with SAWA or their provincial organization.
- **2. Schedule:** The gym opens for team arrival and warm-ups at 7:30 AM. The tournament starts promptly at 9:00 AM and will continue until all matches are completed.
- **3. Facility Rules** (New Floor): Due to the new gymnasium floor, outdoor shoes are not permitted inside the gym. Please bring a separate, clean pair of indoor athletic shoes to wear.
- **4. Food and Drink**: Outside food and drinks are not permitted. A fully stocked canteen will be available on-site for purchases.
- **5. Admission:** The admission fee is \$5. Children 12 and under are free.
- 6. Officials' Breaks: Officials will take rotating lunch breaks on each mat to ensure continuous competition.
- 7. U9, U11, and U13 Rules:
 - •Co-ed: The Freshie (U9), Novice (U11), and Peewee (U13) age divisions are co-ed.
 - Match Format: Matches consist of two 2-minute periods with a running clock.
 - Rules: The modified hip-toss rule will be in effect, and gabori maneuvers are not permitted.

8. U15, U17/U19 combined Rules:

- •Gender Categories: The Bantam (U15) and the Cadet/Juvenile (U17/U19) combined age groups will be separated into male and female categories.
- Match Format: Matches consist of two 3-minute periods with a running clock.
- •Rules: Standard wrestling rules apply—the modified hip-toss rule will not be in effect, and gabori maneuvers are allowed.
- **9. First Round Pin Rule:** (U9/U11 Only): For the U9 and U11 divisions only, if time permits during the first round of matches, officials may allow the period to continue after a pin.
- **10. Pooling Athletes:** Weight classes with five or fewer wrestlers will be grouped into pools to ensure more matches.
- **11. Junior Referees**: The Saskatchewan Amateur Wrestling Officials Association (SAWOA) will have junior referees working at this event. We ask for your patience and supportive encouragement as they gain valuable experience.
- **12. Medal Collection**: All medals for a specific club will be bundled together. Club representatives can pick them up at the main table after the tournament's conclusion.
- **13. Exhibition Matches**: Exhibition matches are subject to time availability. Any such matches must be arranged by the coaches.
